Item No. 1. To confirm the 8th minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 21/07/2022

The Head of IQAC presented the minutes of the 8th meeting held on 21/07/2022 for the committee's consideration and approval. After careful deliberation, the committee unanimously approved the minutes.



Item No. 2. Matter Reporting

The University felicitated the G L Bajaj Institute of Technology and Management for receiving the rank in NIRF 2022, ARIIA 2021 and NBA Accreditation of five engineering branches. The chair congratulated all the faculty members and staff of the Institute.

Item No. 3. Matter Reporting

Head IQAC, explained the status of G L Bajaj Institute of Technology and Management in QS I-GAUGE Rating. The G L Bajaj Institute of Technology and Management received the Overall Dimond rating in QS I-GAUGE Rating. The chair appreciated the effort of IQAC team members and all the faculty members and staff of the Institute.

Item No. 4. Review of the Vision of the Institute

The IQAC Head placed the observations of various stakeholders suggesting a review of the vision of the institute to accommodate the Management program effectively. The committee agreed to the observations and recommended placing the issue in the appropriate academic body for consideration.

Item No. 5. Stakeholders feedback Analysis and Internal Academic audit

Head IQAC placed the report of the stakeholder's feedback analysis and Internal Academic audit of the departments. The committee suggested the corrective actions for respective departments. The chair appreciated the efforts of IQAC members and all the departments.

Item No. 6. NBA Compliance for CSE and ME

IQAC took cognizance of the preparation by CSE and Mechanical department for NBA compliance visit. The department members appraise the committee about the status of preparation and compliance report filling.

Item No. 7. Data collection for NIRF

Dr Manas Kumar Mishra, Director, and Chairman IQAC informed that NIRF ranking has been open. In this view, requested the members to suggest the inputs to improve the NIRF ranking. The members suggested to carefully collect and fill the data of all the criteria and specially focus on collection of offer letters and higher studies proof. The committee suggested to motivate the faculty members to publish more research papers in Scopus and Web of Science. The committee members recommended to the Head IQAC to take the NIRF preparation on priority.



Item No. 8. Action plan of NAAC SSR Preparation

Dr. Manas Kumar Mishra, the IQAC Chairman, recommended that an action plan be developed for the NAAC Self-Study Report (SSR), focusing on each individual criterion. It was suggested that the criterion coordinators should collaborate with their fellow members to finalize the preparation process. The committee members recommended to the NAAC Coordinator to take the SSR preparation work on priority.

Item No. 9. Approval of NSS units and discussion about outreach activities

The Institute received the approval for four units of NSS and the Committee members decided in the meeting the NSS programme will be headed by DSW, and the chair suggested to conduct NSS activities in near future inside and outside the campus.

Item No. 10. Sports Achievements

Inter-institute sports tournaments were organized by AKTU for affiliated institution situated near Meerut, G B Nagar, Ghaziabad, Mathura. Our Institute won 8 Gold, 4 Silver, and 4 Bronze medals in events. Winners (Gold Medalists) of each event at the Zonal Level were eligible to participate in State Level Fest.

AKTU Sports Fest 2022 (State Level) was organized by BBDITM Lucknow, in this sports fest our Volleyball Female team, Kabaddi Male team, and Badminton Female team were qualified for the states in team games and from athletics, our students qualified for High Jump Male, Long Jump Male, 800m Run Male, Discuss Throw Female, and Shot-Put Female. A total of 33 students participated in the State Level Fest. Our Institute won Gold Medals in High Jump Male and Discuss Throw Female. A Silver medal in Shot Put Female and Gold in badminton females. The chair congratulated all the participants and winners.

The Intra-College Cricket Tournament held on 8th, 12th, and 13th November 2022 at the college ground was a resounding success. Around 260 students participated in the tournament, representing 20 teams. The chair congratulated the sports team for the successful organization of the Intra-College Cricket Tournament.
