INFORMATION FOR THE FACULTY:

- 1. Prepare, upload and submit date-wise lecture plan to the HOD before commencement of classes & attach a copy in subject course file.
- 2. The attendance should be uploaded on the SIM/Web Portal on daily basis.
- 3. Evaluate answer sheets of ST/PUT and show them to students within three days. Ensure that the marks are uploaded on the SIM.
- 4. No class should be left unattended as per the timetable. If it's unavoidable, proper arrangement and intimation to the HOD is mandatory.
- 5. Obtain proper prior permission from respective HOD before availing any type of leave. Avoid prefixing or suffixing leaves.
- 6. Invigilation duty issued by the exam cell is mandatory. In case of absence, the concerned faculty must provide a substitute.

GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS

- 1. Registration is mandatory before commencement of classes. Late registration will be liable for a fine (Rs 100/- per day w.e.f. official date).
- 2. The duration of ST/PUT will be 2 or 3 hours. ST-1 will cover a minimum of two units, and PUT will cover the whole syllabus..
- 3. A minimum of 75% attendance is required in all theory & practical subject to appear in all exams/tests. A list of students with attendance shortages will be displayed on the departmental notice board before the commencement of each exam. As per university ordinance, a minimum of 75% overall attendance is required to appear in the University End Semester Examination.
- 4. Generally extra classes will not be conducted, therefore, student are required to maintain their attendance in regular classes only.
- 5. RAGGING is a punishable offense. All are required to refrain from it. An FIR shall be lodged against culprits as per government/court orders.
