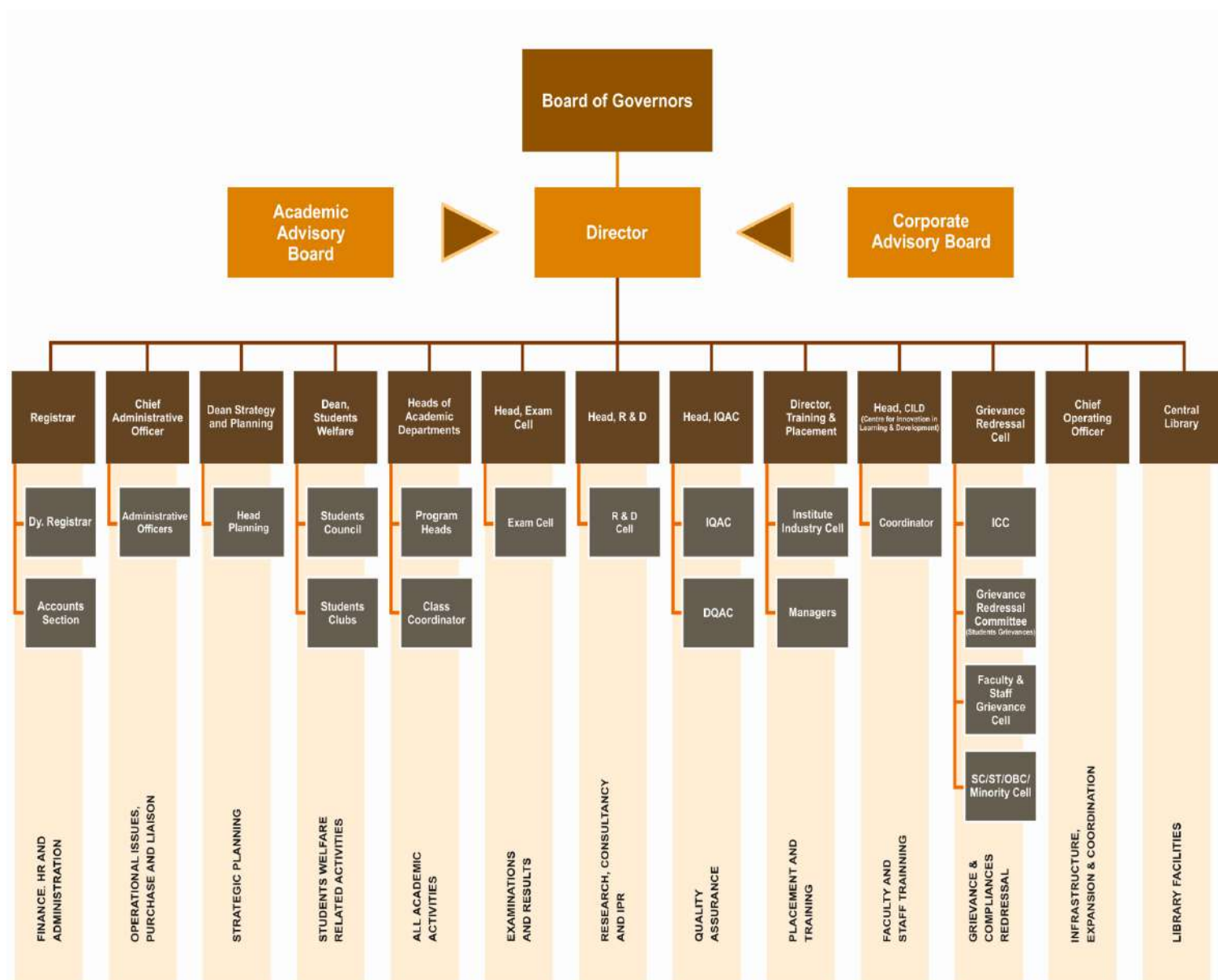

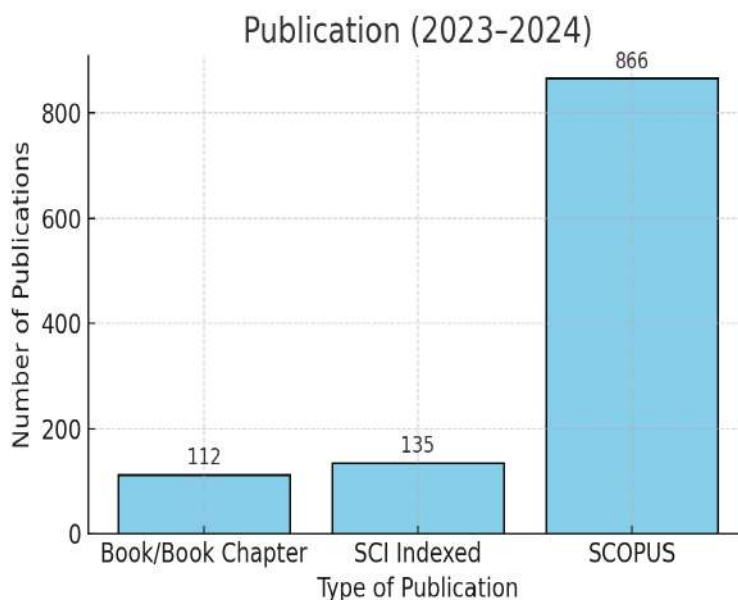
- To motivate faculty members to contribute in research activities so as to publish research articles in Scopus, SCI journals.

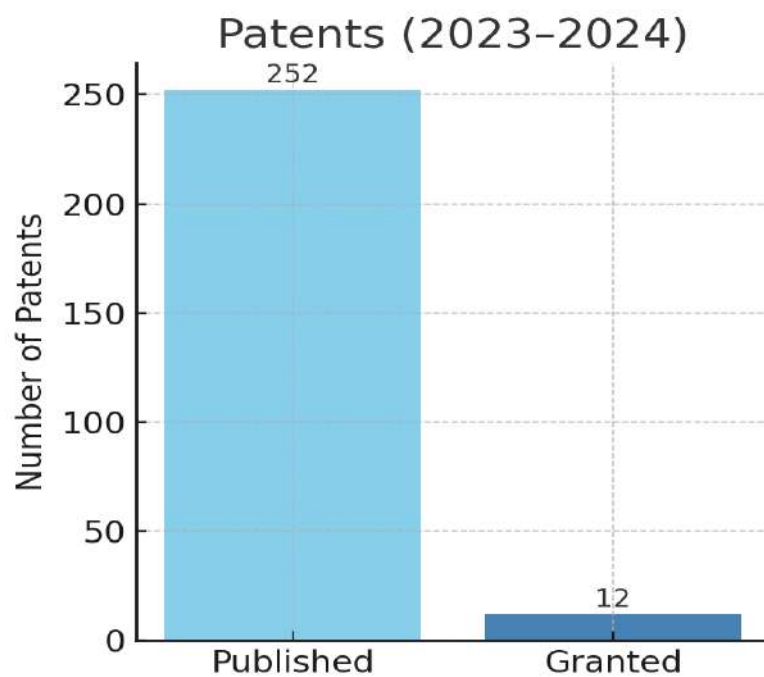
Below graph shows Number of Journal/ Conference/Book Chapter Publication in current academic session.

Research activities:

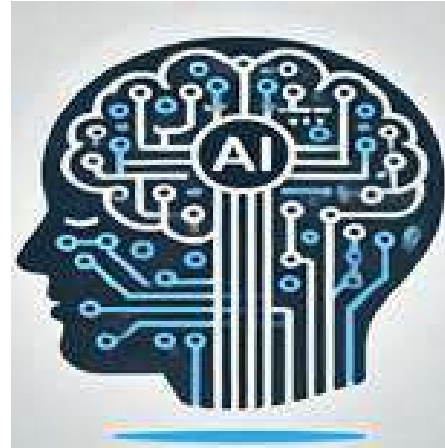

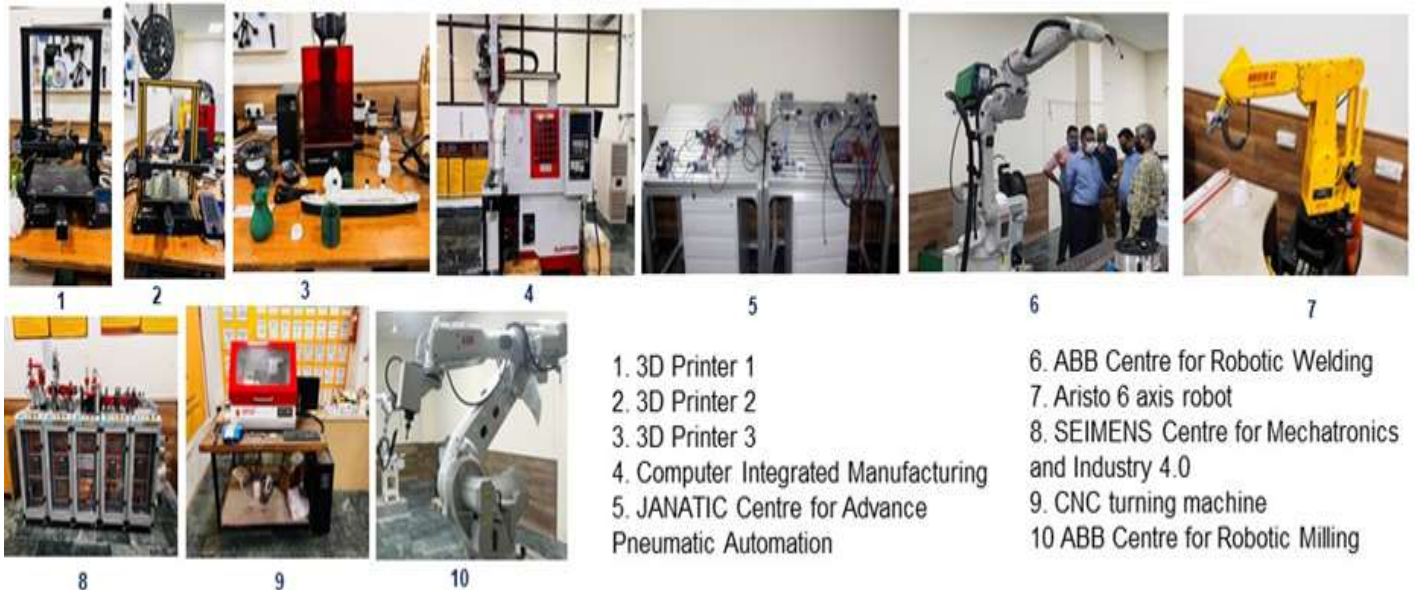
Hackathon: Coding Solutions for Today's Challenges
