The Candidate shall submit a written application, either in person or online (email to feesrefund@glbitm.ac.in from candidate's official or registered email id only), with a formal letter explaining request with reason and supporting by the documents like fee receipt, ID proof, No Dues Certificate and copy of cancelled cheque / bank details. The application should be submitted to the Director Office after a forwarding note from concerned Head of Department or Admission Cell (in case of classes not started) within the institution's specified timeframe as mentioned above. After this, application for refund due to admission withdrawal will be processed according to the institute's refund policy.
