Dr. Manas Kumar Mishra, Chairman of IQAC, extended a warm welcome to all the members present. He acknowledged their continued support in fostering a quality-driven culture in the institution. In his address, he briefed the members present in the meeting on recent achievements and ongoing progress in academics, research, infrastructure, faculty development, and student success.

Item No. 1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 13th IQAC Meeting

The chairman of the IQAC reviewed all points from the minutes of the previous meeting held on 29th May 2024, and invited any clarifications. The members present agreed with the minutes and approved them.

Item No. 2: Preparation of AQAR for 2023–24

The chairman of the IQAC discussed the importance of timely preparation and submission of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the academic year 2023–24. He requested the members to circulate the format among all the departments and sections to ensure that the required data and supporting documents be submitted by the 3rd week of September 2024. He also requested the heads of the departments and section heads to coordinate with IQAC in the preparation of AQAR 2023-24.

Item No. 3: Revision of Vision and Mission of the Institute

The Head, IQAC, apprised the committee that the suggestions made by the NAAC Peer Team during their visit regarding the revision of the Vision and Mission of the Institute had been discussed with various stakeholders. The stakeholders deliberated upon the suggested areas and expressed their concurrence with incorporating these aspects into the Mission of the Institute. They further suggested that the Mission should appropriately reflect the requirements of emerging technologies, changing industry needs, and future societal expectations, so as to effectively support and achieve the well-defined Vision of the Institute.

Based on the inputs and consensus received from the stakeholders, the proposed revision of the Mission was placed before the committee for consideration.

He informed all committee members about the institute's participation in the NIRF rankings within the engineering category. The institute was ranked in the band of 150 to 200. The chair expressed appreciation for the efforts of the IQAC members, as well as all the faculty and staff of the institute.

Item No. 5: UGC 2(f) Recognition

It was proudly announced by the Chairman that the institute has been officially recognized under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act. This milestone marks a significant jump in the institute's academic journey. He thanked all faculty and administrative staff for their dedicated contributions that made this recognition possible.

Item No. 6: Award Distribution on 5th September 2024

Dr. Mayank Singh, Dean – R&D, briefed about the scrutiny of the award applications and the preparation of different types of award distribution on Teachers' Day (5th September, 2024). The chair appreciated the efforts of R & D cell members for the collection and scrutiny of the submitted forms under various categories.
