Faculty Development Program: 'Higher Education, Research, Entrepreneurship - Ask Me Anything'

A one day Faculty Development Program: 'Higher Education, Research, Entrepreneurship - Ask Me Anything' was organized in the campus by the Deptt. of Electrical and Electronics Engineering. The resource person for the session was Mr. Anshuman Tripathi (Sloan Fellow, Stanford Graduate School of Business, California). Anshuman has got an extensive experience in various fields. He has served as a panelist for the National Science Foundation and has holded leadership/Director rolls in various startups and Fortune 500 companies. He is presently perusing a startup in emerging storage media. He has worked in IoT, semiconductor, cloud computing and other industries. He is also the founder of an NGO 'Avlambh' focused on bridging digital device worldwide and holds an US patent in chip design in America.

His energy and enthusiasm was contagious and his diverse experience made him the most eligible mentor to inspire the faculty to excel in the academic world. The major focus of the FDP is on upgrading the teaching, training and research skills of teachers—especially those who have had no opportunity to acquaint themselves with recent developments in teaching methodologies and research. The session enabled participants to develop competence in research and pedagogy.

In addendum, a special session was also conducted by Anshuman Tripathi which highlighted the importance of multilingualism. He also shared a few tips on enhancing communication skills. The FDP boosted the confidence level of young teachers by highlighting the importance of the profession they have chosen and inspired them to improve their communication, presentation skills to deliver knowledge through the most innovative ways. For some senior faculty members, this training will work as a refresher and for youngers, it will be an eye opener.





GL Bajaj Family celebrated 68th Republic Day of India

26th January, 2017, The 68th Republic Day of India was celebrated with all fun and fervor at GL Bajaj Campus. The Chief Guest on the occasion was Sh. Manoj Tiwari, BJP Delhi President, Actor, Singer, TV Presenter and Music Director. The Program started with the lamp lighting ceremony followed by musical tribute to Maa Saraswarti. After that an enthusiastic group of around three thousand members comprised of faculty, staff and students witnessed hoisting of a 100 feet high national flag by the chief guest. On this pious occasion, everyone paid tribute to all those martyrs who had laid down their lives to realize the dream of 'Indian Republic.'

Speaking on the occasion, Sh. Pankaj Agarwal, Vice Chairman of the Institute said that "today India is a rising power, a country fast emerging as a global leader in science, technology, innovation and start-ups, and whose economic success is a matter of envy for the world. Whatever we have today is given by our country to us". He said that 'Desh hume deta hai sab kuch, hum bhi to kuch dena sikhe', hence, it is our duty to give back to the country in whatever form we can. He said that he is delighted that GL Bajaj family is also doing its bit in the making of the nation, but more is required to be done. He quoted Dr. S. Radhakrishnan "End-product of education should be a free creative man", and said that the advent of the 'Global Village' demands that this free and creative man should also be able to master the velocity of change to absorb disruptions which are getting embedded in the systems and societies. He insisted on the need of an eco-system that fosters critical thinking and makes teaching intellectually stimulating. He said that environment must inspire scholarship and encourage unfettered respect for knowledge and teachers and it must instill a spirit of reverence towards women that will guide social conduct of an individual throughout his life. He said that the generational change has happened. Youth have moved centre-stage to take charge. March ahead with Tagore's words "Move ahead, the roll of drums announces your triumphal march; With feet of glory, you shall cut out your own path; Delay not, delay not, a new age dawns." On this reverent occasion, he asked the GL Bajaj family members to pledge to put their minds and hearts together and achieve the pedestal yet not attained and to do their bit with the devotion, dedication and discipline they deserve.

In his address to the audience, the Chief Guest, Sh. Ideation Challenge


