Scholarship for the Economically Weaker Sections of Society

1.0 Objective:

The primary objective of the proposed scheme is to promote the student of economically weaker to pursue the profession courses and come into main stream of society.

2.0 Scope:

G.L. Bajaj Institute of Technology & Management to select number of students from the Economically Weaker Sections of Society.

Requirements and Eligibility

- ➤ Under this scheme 65 students can avail the benefit of total tuition fee waiver.
- ➤ Sons/ Daughters of parents whose annual income from all sources does not exceed ₹. 8.00 Lakh per annum.
- ➤ The total Tuition Fee of the student is waived off under this scheme.
- ➤ In another scheme of fee waiver the amount of ₹. 10000 to ₹. 20000 is waived off to 150 students depending on their annual income and other financial condition of parents.

3.0 Application Process:

- (i) Those candidates who are eligible for the scheme submit the application authority in 1^{st} year.
- (ii) Once all admission formalities are completed, and candidates have registered, the application form for Economically Weaker Section scholarship will be reviewed.
- (iii) College reserves the right to verify the income/asset details of candidate/s who have applied for the aforementioned scholarship.
- (iv) The candidate may be interviewed by the Scholarship committee in case of any clarifications needed.
- (v) In case of any false declaration of documents, college shall suspend the scholarship extended, cancel admission and expel the student from the program.

4. 0 Documents needed for EWS scholarship:

- (i) Self-Declaration: the student applying for the scholarship must submit duly notarized declaration on ₹. 10 stamp paper, co-signed by all earning members of the family.
- (ii) Income Tax Returns of the parents and student for the last two years should be submitted or any other Govt. verified document/s which can ascertain the income and asset level of parent.

College reserves the right to change and/or suspend the Scholarship policy and related at any point of time.
